3. Highlights of Conferences and Workshops Conference

- West Seneca CSD: R. Carraba shared out there will be a course at the West Seneca Central School District teacher Center on tweets and Peeps. She will be sharing the link which will be sent out in a follow up to the CC
- M.Muhlbauer Shared with the group that she had attended the AASL for the first time. She received monies of \$750 to be used towards the conference which was held in Columbus Ohio. She shared that it was a great experience
- M.Sicurella will be attending a SSL conference in Albany,NY in the Spring and will share the details with the group

4.NYLA/SSL Conference

- M.Muhlbauer shared out information related to the upcoming SSL May 2017 Conference. The conference will be May 4-6 and is being chaired by M.Muhlbauer and T.Pierce.
- After much research, consideration and consensus the event will be at the Millennium Hotel [adjacent to the Walden Galleria Mall in Cheektowaga]
- Cost of the conference is unknown at this time however M.Muhlbauer offer suggestions and considerations that will again be explored and discussed

6. UB Vision and direction of the SLMS program

- M.Sicurella shared that the university is looking to Make changes to the core courses and to redesign some of the courses offered
- M.Muhlbauer discussed the LIS 524 course. She shared with the group the syllabus for the course.
 The CC's were allotted time to review the syllabus and offer feedback and suggestions to her to consider and use
- Questions were asked regarding how the university and program is recruiting, how many are currently in the program, how many are expected to graduate, how many are local students, how many credits are needed for certification
- M.Sicurella was asked about and will share out with the CC's the program brochure. The brochure link will be shared out in a follow up email to the CC's

7. Using Google Drive and Google Classroom with Gale databases

- S.Kane and A.Marshall gave a general overview of how Google classroom and Google drive are being used at Williamsville CSD and Cleveland Hill UFSD. They demonstrated how general practitioners can locate and use features and how students are using the features in preparing research projects and other assignments. R.Carrabba, West Seneca CSD and N.Donnell, Ken Ton UFSD, J.Santomauro, Mt St Mary Academy and E.Kick, Frontier CSD also shared that is is being used at their building /districts.
- After the expressed interest from the general overview presented, AT asked the if this was something that the SLS provide more PD on for the th e2016-17 school year. The response was yes and AT will follow-up with more info at a later date

8. Staff Development Opportunities

- On Feb 3rd, the vendor Learning A-Z hosted a ½ day afternoon workshop. The workshop was geared towards the elementary and MS grades SLMS and district colleagues that use the database. It was well attended and the participants stated that they would be appreciative of a follow-up PD in the Fall of the next school year

- The follow-up PD to the Fall SS Framework PD is being planned for Wed. June 1, 2016. This PD is
 not just limited to those who attended the Fall workshop; it is open to all. The workshop will focus
 on many different cultural partners who can offer details and information to add to and enrich
 curriculum
- L.Penn shared feedback on a WNYLRC PD that she attended. The theme was 60 sites in 60 mins. Additional info will be shared in a follow-up email to CC's

9. SLS Director Report:

- A.Thompson shared the proposed 5 year plan of service for the Erie 1 SLS. It is for years 2016-2021. It is officially due to be submitted by April 1, 2016. AT asked for review of the doc and any suggested changes. AT would like to set a target date to send in by early March 2016
- The tentative pricing guide was shared with the CC's. A. Thompson strongly encouraged CC's to share out the information with a vested stakeholder who are involved with the selection or approval of such purchases for the planning of the 2016-17 school year. All CC's have received a paper copy. An electronic copy will be sent to those independent school and districts that collectively do not have any overdue ILL monthly stats due to the SLS office. The final price list and order form is expected to be sent out in Early April. More info is to be shared at the last CC meeting
- There was a question of a possible NEWSELA Trial for the membership. AT will look into
- A. Thompson reminded CC's to follow-up with their district colleagues to send in unaccounted for ILL stats. Each CC was given a list of those buildings within the district that have not sent the records of ILL's stats from September-January
- CC's will be asked to complete the 2016 Summer School Directory Form and send it to the SLS Office. More info to follow at a later date
- The NOVELNY 2017 Databases Procurement Team will begin meeting in January. Team members are Carol Desch (NYSL), Mary Anne Waltz (NYSL), Cara Janowsky (NYSL), Julia Corrice (SCRLC), Lynn Miller (SC BOCES), Lindsay Stratton (PLS) and Amy Heebner (NYSL, Team Leader). - The SLS Council will be asked to offer suggestions on the SLS membership survey for the 2015-16 school year. The suggestions will be used to collect the necessary feedback for the purposeful and professional planning of the 2016-17 school year
