Conference Highlights

- H.Mussachio shared out feedback and thoughts on the WNYLRC Copyright Workshop which was held Wednesday, April 22nd 9:00am-1:00 pm. She shared out that the information was good and that there is a lot to consider when addressing copyright among faculty
- It was shared out that the Erie 1 SLS team attended the WNYLRC Council Annual Meeting: Touch Conversations on April 24th. The attendees were more notably from the academic and public libraries. She asked the CC's if the time of the meeting was an issue as to why the school library attendance was not visible or the focus of the annual meeting was the issue. The welcomed feedback which indicated, the time, lack of communication from WNYLRC and the topics of focus [not school library orientated] will be shared with the WNYLRC Council so that this can be used for future planning consideration for upcoming events

Online Resources:

- The World Book vendor Rep., John Gummoe spoke with the group. He demonstrated and discussed the new eBook pricing. He shared out the trial password that is available thru on the SLS webpage
- The Lincoln Library Rep. Susan Gall spoke with the group. She discussed different databases offered thru the SLS,new bundles and what features are offered[i.e. some Lexile, audio read and citation] There was much interested from the CC's regarding the Defining Moments and Science database
- A.Thompson reviewed with the group the 2015-16 online database order form and pricing guide. The new items on the listing were again highlighted. She also reminded the CC's about the due date the signed forms are needed to place orders to avoid licenses being shut off for districts

- CC's were asked to share back with the vested interested parties that MYOn can also be purchased thru the SLS office. A handout was in the CC folder. PebbleGo has added PebbleGo Dinosaur. A handout to reference was also placed in the CC folder. A.Thompson mentioned to CC's Movie Licensing USA as a strong consideration for districts to consider for subscription purchase

SLS Director Report:

- The WNYSLSCAT Union will be updated in July. G.Ciszewski demonstrated the new look and functionality of the update. Additionally, a handout was provided in the folder. S.Kane commented that the new look makes good use of the white space
- Info was shared regarding the Uncommon Core Conference coming up August 11th and 12th. CC's are encouraged to remind colleagues to look at attending the conference or even present at the upcoming summer conference. A handout was provided in the folder
- A. Thompson shared that the ILead team will focus on the SS Framework to introduce the IFC
- The SLMPE rubric is being reviewed by the Library summit Team. A.Thompson asked the membership present how many are using the document as an evaluation tool. The document was placed in the folder as a tool to reference. It is a good tool to reference in collaboration with the building admin about the overall function/role of the LMC
- The topic of the APPR and how it will impact the SLMS was discussed. At this time it is still not resolved. When more information become available the SLS Office will share out any details
- A. Thompson reported the following: that the Erie 1 Plan of Service for 2016-2020 will be due next year, it will be reviewed by the council for insight and input
- A.Thompson will be one of 4 other SLS Directors to represent the Erie 1 in the ILEAD Project. The team focus is to create a digital interactive platform using the IFC that connects skills to assessments

Additions to the SLS Professional Collection:

• The CC's were sent an email with attachments to share with their colleagues. [handout provided]The goal of the Erie 1 SLS is offer eBooks' to the membership that is based on the content needs and feedback of the membership

Staff Development:

- The Erie 1 SLS hosted 4 PD webinar sessions with Techingbooks.net on April 15th, April 23rd, April 28th and May 6th. The agenda was specifically tailor to the needs of the constituents. The feedback indicated that many like the idea and hope to view the archived webinar
- A. Thompson discussed the need to start the school year with a PD based on the SS Framework for October 19th. The PD will be geared for both the SLMS and the SS [or ELA] content area teacher. AT disseminated the SS Framework to shared back with district colleagues to have for reference to the upcoming PD
- There is also a need from the membership to have a presenter on Copyright for the 2015-16 school
