There was a general question and comment with the new BEDS process. The BEDS information is on the SLS website and additional info was sent to you if you are a member of the library automation CoSer.

#### **Union Catalog and ILL:**

- Comment was made that the Union Catalog was cumbersome followed with a comment that some really like the new OPALS Union Catalog.
- The SLS office is strongly recommending that the Safari browser is used not Internet Explorer. It is on the MainPage of the Union Catalog. There have been several issues with the catalog for users when the internet explorer browser was used.
- There was a general question on how to get the stats for a number not a percent of items loaned and borrowed. The report information was revisited and demonstrated by Gary Cieszewski using Cleve Hill MS/HS as the model school.
- Question regarding the stats for ILLS in general and at the district level. It was explained that if
  you are solely using the OPALS for all ILL transactions, including between school buildings within
  your districts that you will not have to use the form sent by the SLS Office to records the ILLS. If
  you are not using the OPALS Union Catalog to records transitions ILL transitions between district
  buildings, you must use the online monthly stats form sent from the SLS Office. All ILL
  transactions must be tracked and reported to the State. The SLS office will send out a
  questionnaire to the schools to see who is using solely the OPALS for ILLS or a combination.
- There was a question regarding the DO NOT REPLY that appears on the ILL request. If you need to reply to the requestor, you need to click on the note within ILL and make a public note. This will allow the requester to receive and see the message.
- Concern that some still do not know to use the union catalog. The WNYRIC Library Automation
  Pathfinder homepage was demonstrated by Gary Ciszewski. This was revisited as it was addressed
  last year. The WNYRIC pathfinder webpage has links to tutorial videos on how to create and
  submit ILL requests. If there are any general questions, call the SLS office and we will walk you
  thru the process.
- A Subject listserv was created to address concerns expressed last year. The listserv is thru the WNYLRC. It was explained that it is the only option available currently as the OPALS vendor is still working on an alternative.

 Additionally, Erie 1 is still working on a solution with the vendor to minimize the amount of paper used for ILL transactions.

#### Online Resources:

- The online resources available for 2014-15 were reviewed. Discussed that the Business Admin for the district will be receiving the information soon.
- Discussed issues and concerns with subscriptions renewals. The SLS office is still working to resolve issues with ProQuest, EBSCO, Scoholatic.
- Question with the ebrary accounts. The issue has an open ticket and the problem is believed to be with IP addresses.
- Discussion regarding the subscriptions the SLS purchases. The info is with the BEDS information. There was a question regarding the Green file databases and A. Thompson will look into it. It was believe to be a free one offered thru NOVELNY.
- The SLS Membership directory is almost ready to be sent. The SLS is still collecting information from the SLMS for the directory. The directory is shared with local SLS directors, SED, WNYLRC and on the SLS webpage. It is password protected and not made available to any vendors.
